- How hygienically the food is handled (i.e. how it is prepared, cooked, re-heated, cooled and stored)
- The physical condition of the business including cleanliness, layout, lighting, ventilation, pest control and other facilities
- The management process of keeping food safe, looking at processes, training, and systems to ensure good hygiene is maintained
