Bozeat After School Club

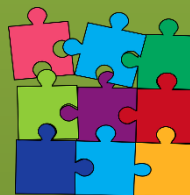
Over the next few weeks we have lots of fun activities planned in our After School Club, including cake decorating, making fruit salads and creating art work using natural materials that we can find on the school site.
