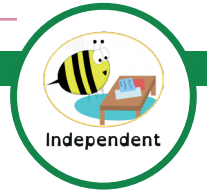

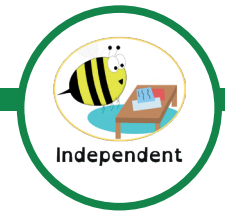

I want to end my story by leaving my audience in suspense, so I’m going to use an \_\_\_\_\_ to keep the reader guessing as to what will happen next.

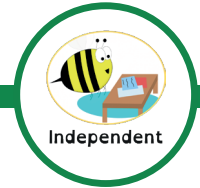
